To the Adjunct Professor:

Independent Legal Writing (course 656) is offered for one or two credits and consists of preparation of a research paper under the supervision of a faculty member. The paper must be based on sound legal research, double-spaced, and conform to the legal citation rules recognized and adopted by the Law School. Typically, the one credit class is approximately 15 pages in length, while the two credit version is approximately 30. Moreover, on specified dates, the following are due to the faculty member: (1) the topic and length of the paper, (2) an outline of the paper, and (3) one or more drafts of the paper. A separate course, portal, and grade sheet will be created for this class. The Law School does not offer additional compensation to any faculty member agreeing to supervise a paper.
