GW Law in New York Program: In addition to his teaching responsibilities, Professor Kohn coordinates the GW Law in New York program, a semester-long immersive classroom and externship experience for second- and third-year GW Law students interested in business and finance law. GW Law in New York began as a Spring semester program from 2017 to 2022; in 2023, the program expanded to allow students to participate in a Fall or a Spring semester in New York City. GW Law in New York, now in its 12th semester, accommodates anywhere from 12 to 20 students each semester. Students take classes with senior practicing lawyers at major New York City law firms, including Professor Kohn's firm O'Melveny & Myers LLP. Classes include Restructuring, Securities Law, White Collar Crimes. International Project Finance, Mergers & Acquisitions, Legal Drafting, and Professor Kohn's course, Business Lawyering. Professor Kohn also develops bi-monthly Wednesday workshops and programs hosted at law firms to enhance the student learning experience. Students are required to obtain a semester-long externship. Professor Kohn monitors student externships and regularly meets with students to discuss their professional development.
