Student Instructions for Remote Proctored Exams

Before you begin...

Make sure your computer can handle the demands of the exam4 software and computer camera running simultaneously. Opening multiple windows or applications during the exam may slow down your device or cause technical issues, especially on laptops with limited memory or processing power. To avoid disruptions, close any unnecessary programs. Staying aware of your system's capabilities will help ensure a smoother exam experience.


Note: this guide was based on the operation of a Mac computer. Exam4 should function largely the same on a PC as on a Mac, but there might be slight variations on the display and prompts.

Make sure your camera is working.

Disable sleep mode on your computer.


Have your GWorld card handy.

Run a network connectivity check.





Now... let's begin!

Select "Prepare to start new exam." Click "next."




Type in your exam ID. Your exam ID can be found in Exam Scheduler. Select the applicable exam from the pull down menu. In this case, "Practice Exam ON." Then click "next."






Verify that the information is correct. Check the box to reconfirm. Click "Ok."




Read the instructions. Click "Continue."



Set a timer for the duration of your exam. Please note that setting the timer and alerts will not shut down the program. It is your responsibility to manage your time and end your exam after your assigned time has elapsed. Click "Next."

done. Then click "Next."



Type in your exam mode. Check the box on the left to confirm the exam mode entered is as assigned for this exam. Click "Next."




Check the box to reconfirm the exam mode.


Click "Ok."




When you reach this screen,

the verification photos.




At this point, your camera will activate. Click "Ok" to allow it.




Grab your GWorld card. Hold it up to the camera so it is legible and within the rectangle.




Click, "Take Photo." Retake the photo as needed, to ensure it is clear and in frame.




Select "Clear view of your face." Center your face in the oval and select "Take Photo." Retake if necessary.




Now that you've taken both photos, select "Use Photos."




Your exam has now begun. Take a moment to read the instructions.




Select "Resources." Click "Open" to view the exam question document.



The exam questions document will open within the Exam4 window. Please note that you may not download or screen capture the exam. You can click "Side by Side" to view the exam questions and the word processing area simultaneously.




This is what the side by side view looks like. You can hide the exam questions at any time by selecting "Hide."

Click on the tool bar in the upper right.





To check your word count, click "Show Document Statistics."

To re-open the exam question document, click "Show Exam Document."


Click "Insert Answer Separator" to create a divider between your answers.

Click the "Multiple Choice" button to activate the multiple choice feature.






When you are ready to submit your exam, click "End Exam" and then "End Exam Now" in the upper left corner.



Click "Submit Electronically."

Note that you must be connected to Wifi to submit your exam.



Success! Your exam has been submitted. When you are done reading, check the box next to "I understand." Click "Ok."

IF YOU RECEIVE A RED "ERROR ON EXAM SUBMITTAL" message, follow the guidance in the dialogue box. You will be given a 10 minute grace period to log in and submit your exam.
