NEED-BASED GRANT: I am a non-transfer JD candidate and wish to be considered for GW Law *need-based* financial aid. As a condition for receiving any need-based grant, I acknowledge that I am required to accept, borrow, and retain the at least \$20,500 of the Federal Direct Stafford Loan offered to me. GW Law merit scholarships and GW Law need-based grants combined may not exceed the cost of tuition and fees. I must complete the 2026-2027 FAFSA and CSS Profile forms with my information, my spouse's information (if married), and my parents' information.

Note: Students who are ineligible to participate in federal student aid programs, transfer students, and students who have been awarded a merit scholarship of \$22,000 or more are not eligible to participate in the GW Law Need-Based Grant Program. Students receiving benefits through the GW Tuition Remission Benefit Plan (employee, spouse, or dependent) are not eligible to receive Law School funding; this includes Need-Based Grants.

FEDERAL AND PRIVATE LOANS ONLY: I do not wish to be considered for GW Law need-based financial aid, or I acknowledge that I do not meet the eligibility criteria specified above. I request Federal Direct Student Loans only (Direct Unsubsidized Loan and, if eligible, the Direct Graduate PLUS Loan) through the US Department of Education. To receive Federal Direct Loans, I must complete the 2026-2027 FAFSA with my information and that of my spouse (if married).

For New Borrowers after July 1st: I understand that new graduate professional students or transfer students who borrow Direct Loans after July 1, 2026, are not eligible for the Direct Graduate PLUS Loan under HR-1 (July 2025). If applicable, an estimated private loan amount may be included in my financial aid offer. However, I must select a private education lender and initiate the private loan application process for the aid year.
