Permission to take Consortium courses must be granted by the relevant GW Law Program Director, the Director of Graduate Student Services, and the Registrar of Georgetown University Law Center. The grade of Credit (CR) or No Credit (NC) will be recorded for such courses. To receive the grade of CR, a student must attain a grade of C- or higher.

This form is intended only for course work taken during a fall or spring semester. Students seeking to take coursework during the summer term must be admitted as a visiting student to the Georgetown University Law Center. Space in a class is not guaranteed. Students are advised to have an alternate course schedule.
