# District of Columbia → Public Defender Service for the District of Columbia

- Full-Time Attorney
  - o Overview
    - Hire entry level and lateral trial attorneys through a fall recruitment model
    - Non-trial attorneys hired on an as-needed basis
  - o Requirements
  - Process
    - Apply via direct application
  - Deadlines
    - Application opens midsummer
    - Resumes accepted on rolling basis until early fall
    - Final round interview in December
    - Offers made in January/December for start date in October of following year
- Law Clerkship
  - Overview
    - 30 to 40 clerkship positions each semester
    - 55 clerkship positions during the summer
  - Requirements
    - 2L/3L students preferred
    - Will accept 1Ls with relevant pre-law experience
  - Process
    - Applications accepted on a rolling basis
    - 1Ls cannot apply until December 1 of 1L year
  - Deadlines

# Maryland → Maryland Office of the Public Defender

- Attorney Positions
  - Overview
    - Both entry-level and experienced trial attorneys sought
    - Two starting classes: (1) Spring and (2) Fall
  - Requirements
    - Demonstrated commitment to zealous and comprehensive public defense.

- Ability to work in a fast-paced, team oriented environment
- Ability to work independently and effectively manage an active caseload
- Active membership in good standing in Maryland Bar or Bar of another state one month prior to start date
  - Most 3Ls are not eligible
  - Applicants will still be considered if waiting on Bar results

- Deadlines
  - Spring Class 2018 → <u>Application</u> closes November 8, 2017
  - Fall Class 2018 → Application closes October 30, 2017
  - 3L law students successful in applying this fall will be eligible to begin work with OPD with the Spring Class of 2019 → <u>Application</u> closes October 23, 2017
- Law Clerk Positions (current law students)
  - Overview
    - Majority of law clerks work in District offices assisting trial attorneys in the representation of adult and juvenile clients in criminal cases
    - Students interested in non-criminal trial experience should consider
      placement in one of the statewide divisions that offer the opportunity to
      work with a smaller group of attorneys in a more highly specialized area
      of law
      - Appellate → Baltimore City

# Virginia → Virginia Indigent Defense Commission

- Overview
  - Public Defender/Capital Defender positions
    - Each office posts listings for availability on website
  - Internships
    - Contact each individual Public Defender/Capital Defender office directly to verify availability and application requirements
    - Application requirements may vary depending upon the office
- Requirements (varies by office)
  - Resume
  - Cover Letter
  - Writing Sample
  - School Transcript (internship only)
- Process
  - Apply online and office will follow-up for interview(s)
- Deadlines
  - Rolling/As Necessary

# Florida → Miami Dade Public Defender

- Overview
  - Job openings posted on the website as they become available
- Requirements
  - o Resume
  - Writing Sample
  - Statement of interest (volunteer internship)
- Process
  - Can participate in summer internship program where candidate will be evaluated throughout the summer to determine long term fit
  - o Alternatively, others can be screened in a more traditional manner
    - Interview consists of hypotheticals and scenarios
    - Candidate will also face hiring panel who will make the decision as to hire or not
  - Volunteer Internship → Email resume and statement of interest to Kevin Hellman (khellmann@pdmiami.com)
- Deadlines
  - Positions are available as need arises
  - Each year sees new interns and entry-level associates hired, again based on the needs of the office

#### **New York**

- The Bronx Defenders
  - Overview
    - Serves indigent clients, mainly in the South Bronx
  - Requirements
    - All applicants must be dedicated to serving racially and socioeconomically oppressed communities
    - Spanish proficiency is a strong plus
  - Process
    - Apply with cover letter and resume <u>in one document</u> through online posting
  - Deadlines
    - Applications accepted until October 13, 2017
    - Notified by October 30, 2017 if selected for interview
    - Interviews take place between October 30 and December 1, 2017
- <u>Brooklyn Defen</u>der Service
  - Overview
    - Opportunities available for trial attorneys, summer interns and postgraduate fellows
  - Requirements
    - Must be admitted to New York Bar (trial attorneys)
    - Must have demonstrated commitment to criminal defense

    - Application opens July 17, 2017
    - Application ends October 6, 2017
  - Summer internship
    - 2Ls → August 1, 2017 through February 15, 2018

  - Submit the required materials and then candidate will be considered for the position via a Qualifications Appraisal Interview
    - Application/Writing Sample weighted 50%
    - Open Interview weighted 50%
      - Must score above 70% on both aspects to be considered

## Pennsylvania

- Defender Association of Philadelphia
  - Overview
    - Application process commences in the fall for start dates the year after
    - Requires a three year commitment
  - Requirements

  - Process
    - Apply online and then office will follow up for interview if selected
  - Deadlines

### Illinois → Cook County Public Defender

- Overview

  - o TLC Program
    - Deadline to apply in early July with the screening interview held in late
       July
    - Follow-up interview scheduled based on screener performance

## **Georgia** → **Georgia** Public Defender Council

    - Must be able to clear criminal history background check

- Process
  - Apply online and office will follow up if selected for interview
  - Those who apply but are not selected in the priority process can be considered during the regular application process
- Deadlines
  - Fall
    - Regular → July 30
    - Priority → July 1
      - o Priority notification → July 15
  - Spring
    - Regular → Dec 15
    - Priority → Nov 15
      - Priority notification → Dec 1
  - Summer
    - Regular → Apr 30
    - Priority → Mar 1
      - o Priority notification → Mar 15
- Harris County Public Defender
  - Overview
    - Staff attorney positions are posted as they become available
    - Internships offered throughout the year
  - Requirements
    - Interest in criminal defense
    - Available 24hrs/4 days per week for 9 weeks
    - Application
      - Cover letter
      - Resume
      - Transcript
      - Photograph
      - Writing sample or Personal statement
      - Letters of recommendation or references
  - Process
    - Submit all materials via email
    - Candidates selected for an interview will be notified and the process will move forward
  - Deadlines
    - Application → January through April
    - Start date → Wednesday after Memorial Day

## Nevada → Nevada State Public Defender's Office

- Announcements posted on website as positions become available
- Requirements and process vary by position

## Michigan → Legal Aid and Defender Association

- Overview
  - Positions are posted as they become available
  - Most, if not all, positions require at least one year of post-graduation experience in criminal defense
- Requirements
  - o Resume
  - References
  - Writing Sample
- Process
  - Apply via directions in online posting and then office will follow up if selected for an interview
- Deadlines
  - Rolling, based on the posting

# New Jersey → Office of the Public Defender

- Applications for attorney positions are accepted continuously
- Applicants should contact William Wander (<u>human.resources@opd.nj.gov</u>)

## North Carolina → Office of Indigent Defense Services

 Opportunities are varied depending on the office and applicants should contact each office directly to enquire about available positions

### **Federal Defenders**

- Each federal district has federal defenders available to represent defendants in court
  - Each district has its own hiring needs and practices
- Positions are posted based on availability in each district on the website

### **Public Sector Recruiting Program**

- Occurs every January in partnership with Georgetown
- Multiple public defender offices, mainly from Virginia, are present and interviewing for both summer and post-graduate positions

#### **Gideon's Promise**

- Overview
  - Summer Law Clerk
  - Brings students interested in public defender work together with public defender offices

- Partnered with public defender offices across the nation
- Requirements
  - o Resume
  - Writing sample
  - Two letters of recommendation
- Process
  - After application, selected candidates are move on to Round 2, where they have to complete a 30-minute interview
  - o Final decisions are made within two weeks of the interview
- Deadlines
  - o December 15 for the following summer

### **Equal Justice Works Fellowship**

- Overview
  - Candidates work with prospective hosts to design and project and apply for the Fellowship
  - o Fellows are required to design the project for their Fellowship prior to applying
  - o Fellowship is a two-year commitment
- Requirements
  - Application must include project description, timeline, and resources/supervisors who are working with Fellows to complete the project
- Process
  - Identify the issue
    - Lay out the problem the Fellowship will aim to solve
  - Find the partner
    - Find an office/organization that is committed to hosting the candidate and this project
  - Design the project
    - Lay out how the project is to proceed for the duration of the two-year commitment
- Deadlines
  - o June 28, 2017 → Application opens
  - September 27, 2017 → Application due by 11:59pm
  - December 2017 → Interviews commence
  - o December 2017-April 2018 → Offers made on rolling basis
