## **LOAN REPAYMENT ASSISTANCE PROGRAM (LRAP) 2022-2023 APPLICATION PROCESS**

Applicants to the GW Law School Loan Repayment Assistance Program (LRAP), as described in the LRAP Program Information document, should submit a complete application file containing the following items:

- 1) LRAP Application (available September 1, 2022).
- 2) LRAP Employer Certification (available September 1, 2022).
- 3) Current income/wage statement from your current employer OR most recent W-2 reflective of annual income (please mask/redact your SSN prior to submission).
- 4) Federal Student Loan history from Federal Student Aid:
  - a. [studentaid.gov](https://studentaid.gov)
  - b. Use your FSA-ID and password to login (same as for your FAFSA when you were a student)
  - c. At the top of the screen, under your name, click “Dashboard”
  - d. On the next screen, in the section for “My Aid,” Click “View Details” to the right.
  - e. On the next screen for LOANS, click “Download My Aid Data” to the right.
  - f. Submit the electronic .txt file as part of your LRAP application; DO NOT submit a PDF or Microsoft Word version of the document. Your application will not be processed unless the electronic version of the file is submitted.
- 5) If you received any private educational loans during your law school enrollment, please provide current balance and monthly payment statements from each of those loan providers (private educational loans ONLY). NSLDS will not have private education loan history.

Documents such as federal and state income tax returns are not required as part of the LRAP application process.

Applicants acknowledge that all documents submitted as part of the LRAP Application process will be retained by the GW Law School Financial Aid Office in the applicant’s LRAP file according to the university’s required record retention period. **TIMELINES FOR APPLICATION MATERIALS:**

The 2022-2023 LRAP application will be available beginning September 1, 2022.

The LRAP Award Year runs from July 1, 2022 through June 30, 2023. All LRAP application data should be presented within the context of this Award Year definition. The application deadline for 2022-2023 will be **September 30, 2022** with disbursements occurring in November 2022 and April 2023.
