THE GEORGE WASHINGTON UNIVERSITY LAW SCHOOL SUPPLEMENTAL LEGAL EDUCATION PROGRAM

The Law School offers an extensive schedule of Supplemental Legal Education ("SLE") courses, for attorneys. All courses listed in the Law School Bulletin are available (space permitting) to SLE students with the exception of : required first-year J.D. courses (numbered 217 and below), independent legal research and writing courses, legal clinics and outside placement, trial and moot court competitions, Law School publications, and courses related to the Oxford-GW International Human Rights Law Program.

SLE students are not officially admitted to The George Washington University. They do not take examinations or receive grades in their courses, nor do they receive academic credit that would count toward a degree. SLE students are not entitled to student activities or medical privileges at the University. After completing a course, SLE students are entitled to receive a certificate of completion.

Graduates of ABA- accredited law schools may take courses on a SLE basis if seats are available after regular degree candidates have been accommodated.

Attorneys seeking competence in an advanced professional area may choose courses in many areas of concentration, including:

Environmental Law Government Procurement Law Intellectual Property Law International and Comparative Law

Registration: Once admitted to the SLE Program, registration is simply completed by payment of tuition fees, which are as follows*:

2 credit course- \$4,450.00 3 credit course- \$6,67500 4 credit course- \$8,900.00
